Medical Scholars Seminar Course - Fall 2021

This is a small group, 3 credit, seminar course (RSRH 7201) for VP&S students in *Fundamentals* interested in research and the MD/Masters in Biomedical Sciences dual degree program. It meets two to three times monthly during both semesters of the academic year. During the first semester, students attend seminars led by CUMC faculty who are active investigators and who discuss their perspective on and experiences in integrating research and medicine. During the second semester, CUMC faculty discuss various skills and topics that enhance students' abilities to conduct research and communicate their results. Students select a specific area of research focus and a mentor or mentors, formally present the proposals for their summer research projects, including their hypotheses, relevant background and significance, and the methods they will be using to test their hypotheses to Dr. Lalwani and the students in the class.
