This checklist has been provided to assist you with determining if you have taken the required pre-requisite courses for Columbia University's Doctorate of Physical Therapy Program. Each prerequisite is listed below with specific requirements. In person courses are preferred, especially for those requiring labs. However, given the pandemic, we recognize the challenges presented for in-person education. Therefore, online courses **do not** need to be approved by the Program's Admissions Coordinator.

Please review the following pre-requisite check list in detail. If you find that you still have questions, please follow the instructions provided at the end of this document.

BIOLOGY I (4 CREDITS)

One 4-credit basic biology course with lab.

Courses for science majors with lab are preferred.

Course must be taken within **10** years of application.

BIOLOGY II (4 CREDITS)

One 4-credit basic biology course with lab.

Courses for science majors with lab are preferred.

Course must be taken within 10 years of application.

Chemistry I (4 credits)

One 4-credit chemistry course with lal	b.

CHEMISTRY II (4 CREDITS)

One 4-credit chemistry course with lab.



Course must be taken within 10 years of application.

PHYSICS I (4 CREDITS)

One 4-credit physics course with lab.

Courses for science majors with lab are preferred.

Course must be taken within **10** years of application.

PHYSICS II (4 CREDITS)

One 4-credit physics course with lab.
Courses for science majors with laboratory are preferred.
Courses must be taken within 10 years of application.
Human Anatomy (4 credits)
One 3-credit anatomy course - lab is not required but preferred.
Many Universities offer Anatomy and Physiology I and II with lab, these courses fulfill the requirement and are preferred.
Course must be taken within 5 years of application.
Human Physiology (3 credits)
One 3-credit physiology course - lab is not required but preferred.
Many Universities offer Anatomy and Physiology I and II with lab, these courses fulfill the requirement. Exercise Physiology does not meet this requirement.
Course must be taken within 5 years of application.
One Additional Science Course (3-4 credits)
One additional 3-4 credit science course
Upper divisional science courses are preferred.
Course must be taken within 10 years of application.
Psychology (6 credits)
Two 3-credit psychology courses
Course must be taken within 10 years of application.
Social/Behavioral Science (15 credits)
Five 3-credit social/behavioral science courses.
Social/ behavior science requirements cover a broad range of subjects that most institutions require as a partial fulfillment of a baccalaureate degree. Courses may include, but are not limited to anthropology, communications, history, law, political science, economics, government, psychology, sociology, classics, literature, philosophy, religion, art history and dance.
STATISTICS (3 CREDITS)
One 3-credit statistics course
Must be taken with biology, mathematics, or psychology departments. If taken through health sciences please send the course description for approval.
Business or economics statistics does not fulfill this requirement.

Course must be taken within **10** years of application.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

One (1) letter from a physical therapist.

Two (2) academic letters of recommendation, one from academic major.

VOLUNTEER OR WORK RELATED EXPERIENCE (OBSERVATION HOURS)

Minimum 75 hours, which can be completed at one facility or a combination of practice environments. Recommended: 100 hours. Verification of hours by a physical therapist is required.

CERTIFICATION IN CPR AND FIRST AID

Please upload it to the documents section of the PTCAS application. CPR First Aid combination courses are acceptable and may be taken after acceptance but prior to program admission.
